However, it was brought to our attention that certain groups/individuals, some with unconfirmed identities and fake social media profiles, have been spreading rumors about our working group in the hopes of getting attention from the public. We strongly condemn the act of what seemed like an orchestrated political agenda with no good intentions for our struggle. The name smearing campaigns target the supporters of the Oromo Liberation Front (OLF), working groups like us, individuals who sacrificed their lives for the Oromo people, and those who highly regard and support the organization!
